

Kindly refer to the above cited subject. In this context the Secretary, Ministry of Education, School Education and Literacy, Govt. of India vide D.O No. 1-30/2020-KT dated 25/08/2020 and communication letter F.NO 1-30/2020-KT Dated 26/06/2020 where under the objective of the PM e-VIDYA programme and its focus on unification of efforts to enable multimode access to Education were highlighted. A virtual workshop was conducted by NCERT with all the States UTs on 04th August 2020 detailing out the process for planning and implementation of Coherent Access. NCERT's Coherent access programme was to be launched on 5th September 2020 wherein content for grades 1st to 12th was to be broadcasted on SWAYAM PRABHA/Television. A unique QR Code was also to be imposed on each telecast content on scanning the QR Code video recording of the telecast content as well as additional digital content in the form of e-Textbook, Explanation content, practices resources, learning resources and teaching resources could be accessed on DIKSHA for consumption.

Dear School Education Secretary,

Please recall that in my letter F.No 1-30/2020-KT dated 26th June 2020, the objective of the PM eVIDYA program and its focus on unification of efforts to enable multi-mode access to education were highlighted. In this context, NCERT's coherent access program will be launched on 5th September 2020 wherein content for grades 1st to 12th will be broadcasted on Swayam Prabha/television. A unique QR code will also be imposed on each telecast content. On scanning the QR code, video recording of the telecast content as well as additional digital content in the form of e-TextBooks, explanation content, practice resources, learning resources and teaching resources can be accessed on DIKSHA for consumption.

2. NCERT has defined a process note which can be referred by the States/UTs to implement coherence with customization as deemed fit. The process note has been enclosed as Annexure A of the letter.

3. A virtual workshop was conducted by NCERT with all States/UTs on 4th August 2020 detailing out the process for planning and implementation of coherent access (presentation used in the workshop is enclosed as Annexure B).

4. Few States/UTs have already started leveraging multiple other mediums to achieve coherent access:

- Gujarat:** Television broadcast sessions on Doordarshan for students across grades. TV content is uploaded and linked to digital textbooks on DIKSHA in advance for asynchronous learning
- Tamil Nadu:** State launched a Learn at Home programme on July 15th which focuses on telecasting explanation videos for all chapters for grades 1-12. The telecast is planned such that one channel is dedicated for one class. Out of the 14 TV channels, 10 channels have started telecasting from 3rd August, 2020.
- Assam:** State is telecasting TV sessions through SWAYAM DTH Prabha channel and DD Guwahati. Radio sessions are also being conducted. All the aforementioned contents are also being uploaded on DIKSHA to ensure coherent access.

5. In the aforementioned context, States/UTs are requested to undertake the following actions for ensuring effective coherence across digital modes of school education:

- States/UTs that are leveraging NCERT textbooks are required to popularize the NCERT coherence program so that all teachers students parents can be made aware of the availability and accessibility of content across mediums
- States/UTs that are not using NCERT textbooks are to ensure that their respective coherence programs are launched by 5th September 2020. A flyer on coherence has been enclosed as Annexure C of this letter and can be


customized by each State UT and used as one of the outreach mechanisms for their coherence program.

- c) DIKSHA provisions various dashboards to track digital content coverage, content consumption as well as other parameters which can be used to gauge the success of the use-cases programs launched on the platform. All states UTs are requested to leverage dashboards for improving content as well as bridging the chapter wise gaps. The suggested template (enclosed as Annexure D) providing the content coverage and gaps against the various content types should be shared. DIKSHA coordinators appointed by state UTs can reach out to DIKSHA PMU member(s) for the content gap sheet.
- d) The states UTs are requested to share the filled template at a monthly frequency, starting 15th September, 2020 at dir@india.gov and takeshverma@teamdiksha.org.
- e) Furthermore, to ensure the learning continuum of teachers in the absence of classroom face-to-face training models, CBSE, NCERT and multiple States UTs have launched online training courses on DIKSHA. Data/dashboards related to consumption of these courses are emitted by the platform which can be used by the state administration to drive action towards their respective teacher capacity building programs. A summary on teacher professional development capabilities on DIKSHA is enclosed as Annexure E.

I look forward to your acknowledgement of this letter and response regarding action taken in this context.
