Subject: Awareness Generation about POCSO -e-Box for reporting child Sexual offences online.

The national commission for protection of child has been mandated under section 44 of the protection of children from sexual offences (POCSO) Act, 2012 and Rule 6 of POCSO Rules, 2012 to monitor the rights of children under the said act.

In order to increase the reach of the Commission and monitor instances of sexual offences against children in an expeditious manner, an online 'POCSO' e-Box (an online complaint management system) has been created and launched by the commission recently.

The POCSO e-button shall enable easy online registration of grievances pertaining to sexual offences committed against any child by enabling the child victim or any other adult on his/her behalf to register complaint by visiting NCPCR website (<a href="http://ncpcr.gov.in/">http://ncpcr.gov.in/</a>) and clicking POCSO e-Box.

In this regard you are directed to issue relevant notifications/ orders to schools and other stakeholders with a direction to spread awareness about the creation of the POCSO e-button and to display emergency contact numbers **09868235077,1098(Child line)** on school Notice Boards and walls to let the child contact in case of any instance of sexual offence or Abuse.
