- 2) Teaching staff shall report to their respective schools on 21-07-2026 for the readiness of school for students like cleanliness, preparation of Teaching Learning Material, Lesson planning, Time table planning, preparation of facilities for online classes like ICT Lab, etc.
- 3) All teachers shall remain available for any on-line guidance of students during vacations period.
- 4) Summer Tutorials/Remedial Classes shall be arranged in designated schools (HSS and HS) for the academic support and learning enhancement of students as per Annexure A.
- 5) Scholastic Assignment for summer vacations (Govt. Schools) shall be assigned in accordance with the suggestive Scholastic Assignment pattern outlined in Annexure-B enclosed herewith.
- 6) Any default on part of the Head of the School/Teaching staff in observance of the above directions shall attract action under rules.

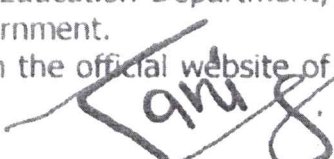

"Annexure A"

Subject: Summer Tutorial Program for Classes 9th to 12th in Government Schools of Jammu Division during Summer Vacation.

In order to strengthen academic support and bridge learning gaps among students at the High and Higher senior secondary levels, it is hereby ordered that Summer Tutorials shall be made operational in Government Schools across Jammu Division for students of Classes 9th to 12th during summer vacation for the academic session 2026-27. The initiative is aimed at addressing learning gaps and improving academic outcomes by providing remedial teachings to students.

The following guidelines shall be implemented for conduct the of summer tutorials:

- These Tutorials shall be organized for students of Classes 9th to 12th.
- Shall be established in centrally located and easily accessible schools preferably having adequate infrastructure and ICT facilities so as to cater to the maximum number of students from the respective catchment areas.
- A minimum number of students shall be ensured in each tutorial batch for effective conduct of classes, and their attendance shall be monitored regularly
- Lecturers, Masters, and Teachers who have volunteered shall be deployed in these tutorials from within schools or clusters.
- Shall primarily focus on remedial teaching, strengthening conceptual clarity, and addressing learning gaps identified through classroom interactions and assessments, rather than completion of the syllabus.
- The timing for the Summer Tutorials shall be from 08:00 AM to 12:00 PM.
- All officers/officials engaged in Summer Tutorials will be eligible for incentives under Rule 27 of the J&K Civil Services (Leave) Rules, 1979, subject to certification by the concerned Drawing and Disbursing Officers, CEOs or Joint Directors, and verification by teams constituted at the Directorate level.

All Joint Directors shall closely monitor the functioning of the Summer Tutorials in their respective jurisdictions and all Chief Education Officers shall ensure proper implementation, monitoring, and supervision of these tutorials, and shall submit progress reports to the Directorate. Directorate-level teams shall also conduct inspections and evaluations to ensure effective execution.

SUGGESTIVE SCHOLASTIC ASSIGNMENT FOR SUMMER VACATION FOR GOVERNMENT SCHOOLS

The summer Scholastic Assignment across Classes 01st to 08th should be based on following:

- Revision of learning based on syllabus covered up to time before summer Vacation
- Focus on foundational literacy and numeracy (FLN) in primary classes
- Progression towards conceptual understanding and application in Middle classes
- Integration of activity-based, experiential, and observation-based learning
- Emphasis on reading, writing, practice work, and projects

Class	Suggestive Assignments
01 st and 02 nd	• Alphabet and number writing practice • Formation of simple words and sentences • Basic arithmetic operations (addition/subtraction) • Drawing, coloring, and identification-based activities. • Development of habits, manners, and environmental sensitivity (e.g., planting a tree)
03 rd	• Reading fluency and daily writing practice • Vocabulary development and sentence formation • Introduction to grammar concepts • Expanded numeracy (tables, operations, number sense) • Environmental awareness through observation and short writing tasks
04 th and 05 th	• Strengthening grammar and paragraph writing • Mathematical operations with larger numbers and word problems • EVS concepts linked to surroundings (environment, health, society) • Chart preparation, observation-based activities
06 th to 08 th	• Completion of textbook exercises for all subjects • Writing of key points and concept summaries • Practice of grammar, formal writing, and problem-solving • Subject-based activities/projects (charts, diagrams, field observations) • Application-based learning in Mathematics and Science.
